Psalm 33 – June 6th, 2021

Praise and Worship- Same or different?

Can they happen simultaneously?

1 Sing for joy in the Lord, you righteous ones;
Praise is becoming to the upright.

What is Joy? Good description - usually
a surprise

2 Give thanks to the Lord with the lyre;

comely, looks right, appropriate

Sing praises to Him with a harp of ten strings.

kinnowar- yes a lyre, little harp but next is **nebel**-
different!

3 Sing to Him a new song;

not parallelism here, a jug or wineskin, with strings,
banjo? Not

Play skillfully with a shout of joy.

perhaps spiritual song? Psalms(plucking
strings)Hymns(praises)

4 For the word of the Lord is right,

not sloppy, skilled string plucker, What instruments
today?

And all His work is done in faithfulness.

FOR- the reasons we sing praises to him are following

5 He loves righteousness and justice;

The earth is full of the goodness of the Lord.

cynics, scoffers, only see the destruction caused by
sin and blame God

6 By the word of the Lord the heavens were made,

God Spoke- the heavens existed, were made(hard
indeed to fathom)

And by the breath of His mouth all their lights.

the light from all the stars by his mere breath

7 He gathers the waters of the sea together as a
heap;

He puts the depths in storehouses.

8 Let all the earth fear the Lord;

Action again

Let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of
Him.

9 For He spoke, and it was done;

FOR- again the reasons follow--God Spoke and it was
done

He commanded, and it stood firm.

stood firm- stable as He made it

10 The Lord nullifies the plan of nations;

brings their plans to nothing

He frustrates the plans of peoples.

They can't get it all figured out to fit their plans,
must be frustrating

11 The plan of the Lord stands forever,
The plans of His heart from generation to
generation.

12 Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord,

The people He has chosen for His own inheritance.

13 The Lord looks from heaven;

He sees all the sons of mankind;

14 From His dwelling place He looks out

On all the inhabitants of the earth,

15 He who fashions the hearts of them all, forms the hearts -interesting

He who understands all their works.

16 The king is not saved by a mighty army;

A warrior is not rescued by great strength.

17 A horse is a false hope for victory;

Nor does it rescue anyone by its great strength.

18 Behold, the eye of the Lord is on those who fear Him, Those who fear Him, those who wait on His faithfulness to rescue

On those who wait for His faithfulness,

their soul from death--These are the ones whom He watches

19 To rescue their soul from death

purpose- also why we wait on Him

And to keep them alive in famine.

20 Our soul waits for the Lord;

He is our help and our shield.

21 For our heart rejoices in Him,

Because we trust in His holy name.

Why do we rejoice in Him, Because

22 Let Your favor, Lord, be upon us,
