# C. Ministry Areas, Roles and Testimonials

#### **Community Group Leaders**

- Teacher role and manage the overall biblical teaching, lessons and content
- Lead doctrinal and biblical role
- Spiritual Head of the Community Group for counseling, calls, questions and overall condition of the spiritual condition
- Direction for shepherding roles within the Community Group.
- Overall leadership and direction for strategy, direction, goals, structure, ministry positions
- Work with Class Leaders for growth in spiritual wisdom, biblical knowledge and leadership skills for CG

#### Class Leaders

- Directly assist the Community Group Leader in the administration and running of the CG
- Responsible for the care and well being of the Care Groups in their Class
- Be strong in your spiritual condition through walking in the Light, maintain your spiritual disciplines, pray, read and seek God's direction in the management of your Class.
- Lead the Care Groups to ensure they are in harmony and addressing any specific shepherding needs.
- Mentor and train the Care Group Leaders for potential Class or Community Group Leader roles.
- Manage and lead the filling of key Community Group Ministry Roles.
- Coordinate and plan CG activities.
- Lead on Sunday's during CG for making announcements, upcoming activities and leading in prayer.
- Class Teaching and Group Discussion Leader
- Coordinates with the introduction of new visitors in class, sends a welcome email and calls them

#### **Care Group Leaders**

- Primary leaders fulfilling the "shepherding roles" within the CG for group of 5-10 families.
- Care Group is the foundation of the CG and the most important element.
- Care Group leaders are the glue that holds the "Family" together. Their shepherding role is conducted during the week by Living Life Together.
- Develop and grow deep relationships with each family within the Care Group.
- Live Life Together with your Care Group families
- Attend CG and Socials on a regular basis to maximize your time and caring opportunities with your families.
- Shepherd your Care Group by calling, encouraging, meeting needs and knowing what is going on in the life of your Care Group family's.
- Coordinate with the Community Group Leaders, Class Leaders and other key roles
- Develop and mold people to fill the Assistant or Care Group Leaders roles
- Develop Social schedules, events or activities to encourage relationships with the Care Group.

#### Special Needs Coordinator and Team

- Serves those who have an immediate need surgery, family hardship or loss, etc.
- Coordinate to provide meals and Christian love to our brothers and sisters in the CG.
- Requires some email work, calling, coordination

#### In-Reach Coordinator and Team

- Plans and manages approximately 4-5 events for the whole Community Group each year
- Requires some email work, calling, coordination and scheduling.

#### **Administrative Coordinators**

- Completed the attendance roll each week
- Provides and gathers the completed visitor's information sheet for each new visitor
- Coordinates with Class leaders to make sure all visitor information is distributed for rosters and contacts.

#### **Ladies Night Out Coordinator**

- Plans and coordinates events for our ladies' in the Community Group
- Requires some email, calling and coordination work.

#### Men's Night Out Coordinator

- Plans and coordinates men's events for the Community Group.
- Requires some email, calling and coordination work.

#### **Greeters**

- Greets and warmly welcomes first time visitors as soon as they come to the CG.
- Makes them feel at home and provide a visitors slip.
- Addresses any questions the visitors might have about the church or Community Group.

• Introduces them to the Class Leaders.

#### **Paper Goods Coordinator**

- Provides paper goods for Class, Care and Community Group socials.
- Coordinate with Treasurer for funding from the Benevolence Fund.

#### **Treasurer**

• Keeps track of all funds collected by the CG for paper goods, benevolence needs, etc. in a checking account fund.

#### Name Tag Coordinator

- Creates and maintains name tags for the CG and visitors.
- Coordinates with the Class Leaders and Administration team for new visitors and other required changes.

### **Dinner/Desert Circle Coordinator**

Schedules and coordinates the dinner/dessert circle activities for the CG.

#### Service Coordinator

- Coordinates with Community Group Leader, Class Leaders and Care Group Leaders to plan and schedule service related activities to groups and people outside of the CG.
- New role with an outward looking focus of servicing for the whole CG.

### **Post Card Ministry**

Manages the gathering, postage and mailing of encouraging post cards to Community Group members.
